Fortunately for you, National University Polytechnic Institute (NUPI), within the National University Division of Extended Studies, offers a broad range of innovative certificate programs that meet your standards so you can continue to build and strengthen your capabilities. NUPI's five-week long course format offers convenient education and training in the rapidly expanding fields of marine technology, construction management, and biotechnology. NUPI facilities are located in San Diego, with some courses and programs offered online allowing you to take them from any place at any time.

Accelerated by design, NUPI's programs can be completed quickly; military divers can complete some programs in less than one year. With classes taught by experienced faculty utilizing state-of-the-art classroom and laboratory equipment, you'll gain the skills you need for professional growth or to begin a new career.



ENGINEERING TECHNOLOGY

NUPI can provide you with the skills and qualifications necessary to enter or advance in the construction industry.

Certificate in Construction Management †

Qualified construction managers are currently in high demand and are expected to remain so for years to come. Learn the skills necessary for estimating, scheduling, bidding, and executing the construction plans developed by architects and engineers. Earn your Certificate in Construction Management and you'll be qualified for a variety of project management positions at design-build, construction management, general contractor, and subcontracting firms. Completion of this program allows you to transfer to National University's Bachelor of Science in Construction Management.

MARINE TECHNOLOGY

Turn your experience and love of adventure and action into a profitable career with a Certificate in Marine Technology. Through a balance of lecture and hands-on courses, you'll develop the skills and experience needed in commercial diving, with programs covering marine technology, commercial diving, dive medicine, and underwater nondestructive testing.

NUPI's Marine Technology Certificate provides you with the skills and training you need to enter the diverse field of commercial diving. Marine Technology I, which gives you the basic skills you need for surface supplied air diving and prepares you for further study. Marine Technology II comes next, improving your skills with 20 weeks of study in one four concentrations that offer advance training for the major employment areas of commercial diving. Available concentrations include:

MedTech—Advanced Dive Medicine

The MedTech concentration prepares students in the medical aspects of diving and advanced training in hyperbaric medicine. Graduates gain certification as an Advanced Diving Medical Technician, qualified for work as a "tender" or diver medic on inland and offshore job sites. This concentration also qualifies you to take the Emergency Medical Technician—Basic (EMT-B) exam.

SpecTech—Underwater Inspection Technology

The SpecTech concentration prepares you to conduct a number of advanced underwater inspection and testing techniques important for insuring the quality of underwater construction. You'll be trained to American Society for Nondestructive Testing (ANST) Level 1 and Level II standards in Ultrasonic Testing (UT), Magnetic Particle Testing (MT), Dye Penetrant Testing (PT) and Visual Testing (VT).

EXTENDED LEARNING—CONTINUING EDUCATION AND RECERTIFICATIONS

In addition to degree and certificate programs, National University Polytechnic Institute also offers a number of extended learning continuing education and recertification courses that are required in some allied health fields.

For students requiring flexibility in their schedules and those who prefer a more “learner-centered” environment with individualized instruction, National University Virtual High School (NUVHS) offers the premier high school online learning experience.

NUVHS helps students achieve academic excellence by offering courses that provide an active, engaging, and cooperative learning experience. Choose from more than 80 online courses that are available in a variety of high school core subject, elective, and Advanced Placement courses. At NUVHS, students can complete a full semester of a high school course in as few as four or as many as 16 weeks on a full- or part-time basis allowing students to improve their grade point average or earn additional credit towards high school graduation or college readiness.

The school features a college preparatory-level curriculum and offers many of the same classes students find in their public or private high school as well as courses that may not be offered within their school districts. All coursework meets or exceeds California and national standards. Each NUVHS course covers a typical semester’s worth of material, and students can start both first and second semester courses at any time during the year.

Core courses offered by NUVHS are approved for initial eligibility certification by the National Collegiate

Athletic Association (NCAA), and all NUVHS Advanced Placement courses have been authorized by the College Board. The school also has “online provider status” through the University of California and multiple courses are approved as meeting the UC “a-g” requirements.

NUVHS strives to make your quality education as affordable as possible and offers scholarships in math, science, and some elective areas. The school is accredited by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC), so colleges will know that you’ve received a quality education at NUVHS.

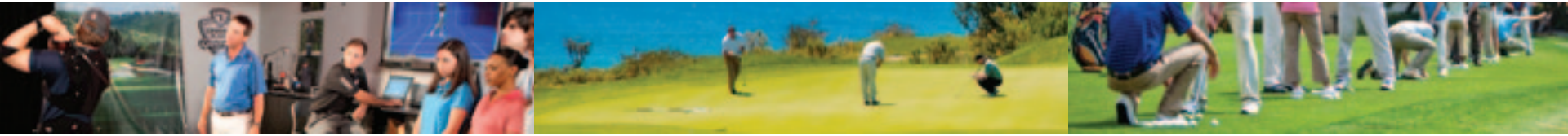
