

Thank you for your interest in the Master of Education in Inspired Teaching and Learning with a Preliminary Multiple or Single Subject Teaching Credential and Intern Option Program. This program is currently operating using California Commission on Teacher Credentialing (CTC) requirements for a Preliminary Multiple or Single Subjects teaching credential and **meet requirements** for a master's degree guidelines that allow a recommendation for **California credentials only**.

A **determination has not been made** as to whether the Program meets the educational requirements for licensure to practice in any other State.

The Master of Education in Inspired Teaching and Learning with a Multiple or Single Subject Teaching Credential and Internship Option is designed for candidates dedicated to inspiring all K-12 learners by ensuring social emotional thriving, meaningful academic achievement, and equitable and inclusive learning communities.

Courses meet the new California Commission on Teacher Credentialing (CTC) Program Standards, including the new 45 Teaching Performance Expectations (TPEs), composing the TPEs six domains and Teaching Performance Assessments (TPA) associated with the revised 2.0 CalTPA model. Students in this degree complete a three-course area of M.Ed. specialization in their selected area of English Language Learner Education, Critical Thinking, Social Emotional Learning or Inspired Teaching Practices.

Students need to satisfy/pass the Basic Skills Requirement (e.g., CBEST) and Subject Matter Competency Requirement (e.g., CSET) early (prior to Credential Area Methods coursework) into their programs to avoid interruptions to program progress and/ or financial aid arrangements.

Candidates who **ALREADY HOLD** a Preliminary Multiple or Single Subjects Teaching Credential and desire an advanced degree should enroll in the Master of Arts in Education Program.

To receive the Preliminary Multiple or Single Subject credential, candidates are required to successfully complete all course work including clinical practice, fingerprint clearance on CTC website, Subject Matter Competency, U.S. Constitution, Satisfy the Basic Skills Requirement, RICA (for Multiple Subject candidates), Passage of Cal TPA Cycle 1 and Cycle 2, Adult, Child and Infant CPR, 3.0 GPA and Zero account balance.

This program must be completed while residing in the state of California. Field Expedience and Clinical Practice Placements cannot be made outside of California. It is the responsibility of the candidate to notify the University of relocation outside of California. .
